

POM POM CHARACTER

·Cut out each circle and centre (so you have 2 matching rings) and stack them

·Press the rings together and wrap yarn around them. It is easier if you use several shorter lengths than one long one. We found the best and fastest way was to cut several lengths of about 70 inches and then wrap 2 or 3 lengths at a time.

·Carefully cut through the yarn around edge of the ring.

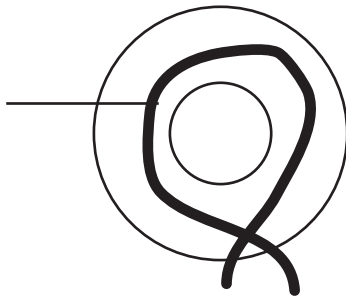
· Place a shorter strand of yarn between rings, as shown at left. You can use a thinner yarn if you like.

·Tighten the centre yarn and tie in a knot (check that it's in place & tight before the next step)

·Remove rings, fluff pom pom, snip bits of yarn that stick out. Tie your long centre yarn ends in a knot to hang, if you like

·Decorate by gluing on eyes and felt pieces for faces
